Ex 20: 12 "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.

**2 Tim 3** But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: <sup>2</sup> For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, <sup>3</sup> unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good,

## 3513 kabad or kabed: to be heavy, weighty, or burdensome

Initiate relationship

Mt 15: <sup>4</sup> For God commanded, saying, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.' <sup>5</sup> But you say, 'Whoever says to his father or mother, "Whatever profit you might have received from me *is* a gift *to God*"— <sup>6</sup> then he need not honor his father or mother.' Thus you have made the [b] commandment of God of no effect by your tradition.

**Eph 6** Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. <sup>2</sup> "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: <sup>3</sup> "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth."

**6. Ex 20:** <sup>13</sup> "You shall not murder. Murder – kill someone with hatred against Deut. 19:4

1 Jn 3: 15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

War is different than "murder" – Jdgs 3:1-3, Ps 144:1, 1 Ki 2:5 (shed blood in peace)
Ps 144: Blessed *be* the LORD my Rock,
Who trains my hands for war,
And my fingers for battle—

(Men and women different – 1 Sam 8:10-13)
7. Ex 20:<sup>14</sup> "You shall not commit adultery.
Married people cannot have sex with anyone except who they are married to

Divorce could be adultery

Mt 19:9 And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except
for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery;
and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery."

Other plausible causes –
Pornography is adultery
If your spouse doesn't provide or abandons you

We should not be looking for a way out, but do our best to make it work

8. Ex 20: 15 "You shall not steal.

Cannot take someone's things without permission of

Cannot take someone's things without permission or legal right without of intention of returning it

Eph 4:28 Let him who stole steal no longer, but rather let him labor, working with *his* hands what is good, that he may have something to give him who has need.

- 9. Ex 20: 16 "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- Cannot accuse people of things they didn't do
  - Be careful spreading things you heard or think
  - Lying about the baby's father
  - Wrongly accusing someone of rape or molestation

Jn 2: <sup>19</sup> Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." Mt 26:61 <sup>61</sup> and said, "This *fellow* said, 'I am able to destroy the temple of God and to build it in three days.'"
