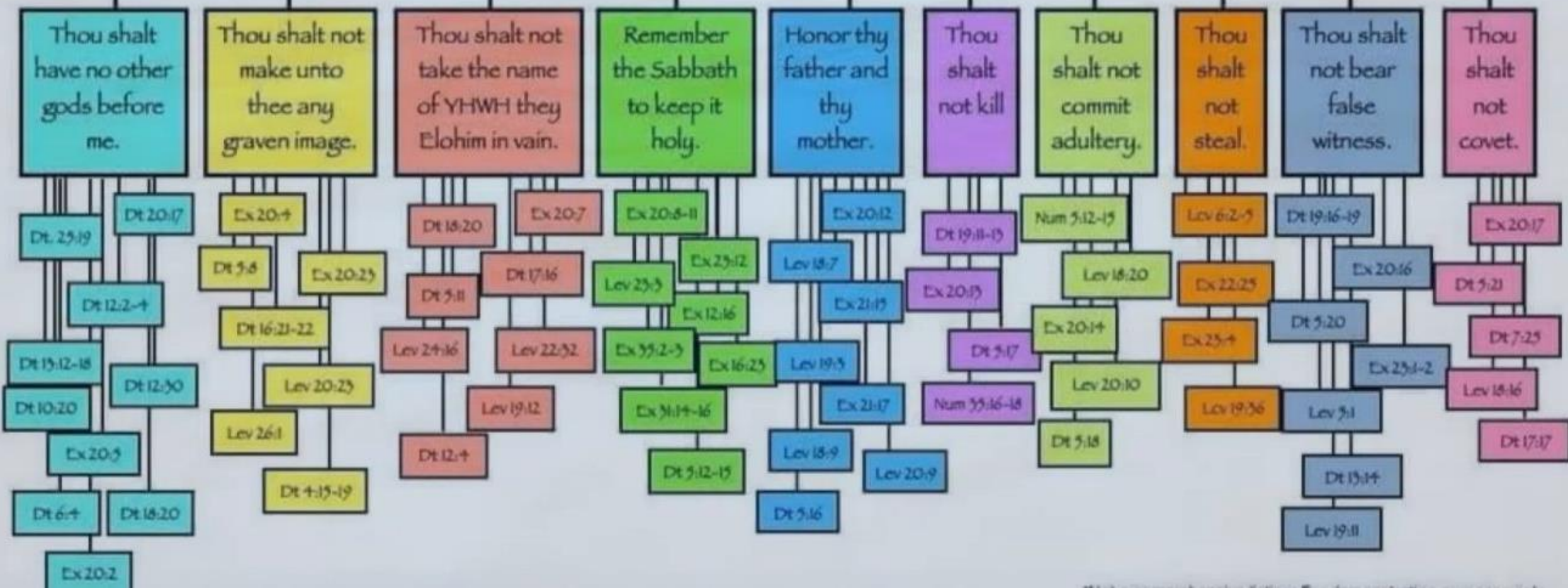

Bible Reading -Deut. 8:3... that He might make you know that man shall not live by **bread alone**; but man lives by *every word* that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.

- Divided into two parts: Old and New Testaments

- Old Testament

- before Christ

- Genesis – Malachi

- **Five Parts**

- **Pentateuch:** Also known as the Torah, this section corresponds to the Hebrew Torah
 - **Historical Books:** Corresponds to the Hebrew Nevi'im (Prophets)
 - **Wisdom Books:** Also known as the Writings, this section corresponds to the Hebrew Ketuvim (Writings)
 - **Major Prophets:** Includes books by Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, and Daniel
 - **Twelve Minor Prophets:** Includes books by Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi

- New Testament

- After Christ

- Matthew - Revelation

- Five Parts

- **The Gospels** -The four Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John tell the story of Jesus' life, ministry, and death.

- **Acts of the Apostles** - A historical book that provides a general history of the church for about 30 years after its beginning.

- **The Pauline Epistles** - Letters written by Paul that helped establish Christians in the faith.

- **The General Epistles**-Letters written by James, John, Peter, and Jude that focus on foundational truths.

- **The Book of Revelation**

- The final book in the New Testament, which is a book of prophecy that describes the destiny of the church and the "End Times".

- Overarching Theme – restoring our relationship with the FATHER and living in His Presence
 - Mankind lost this privilege in Gen 3:22
 - Rev. 21:3 God dwells among the people again
